The tool's ergonomic grip offers comfort and balanced control, and its separate on/off switch lets users maintain a previously selected speed setting upon restarting the tool after it has been turned off. A soft-start feature minimizes abrupt starts and provides a feeling of control as the tool ramps up to the desired speed while electronic feedback maintains consistent speed through even the toughest applications.

The Multi-Max also boasts a wide variable speed range from 10,000 to 21,000 oscillations per minute (OPM) and a powerful 3.5 amp motor.

The Dremel Multi-Max MM35 will be available in September 2018 at hardware and home improvement centers nationwide for a suggested retail price of \$99.99 USD. In Canada, the suggested retail price is \$139 CDN.
